Dear Senators:

The International Warehouse Logistics Association (IWLA) supports AB 2605 in principal but does not support it as currently written. IWLA and the Board of Pharmacy are still working together to reach agreement on further amendments to the bill.

IWLA members are warehouse-based third-party logistics (3PL) providers. Several members have warehouse facilities either in California or outside of California that will be subject to the proposed licensing standards.

IWLA, and its member companies, were actively involved in the process that led to the Drug Supply Chain Security Act and the requirement for national licensing standard for 3PLs.

Our position reflects ongoing discussions with the Board of Pharmacy on additional amendments to conform California's licensing standards for 3PLs to the Drug Supply Chain Security Act (DSCSA) (Title II of the Drug Quality and Security Act of 2013).

We are committed to working with the California Board of Pharmacy and the California Legislature on licensing standards that meet the requirements of the DSCSA and secure the supply chain to protect the health and safety of the residents of California.
